Subject: PLAY RADIO SATURDAY

Enclosed please find the letters sent by the 4 listeners who will be appearing on the air tomorrow during your shows.

They must stick to the lists of music they sent; if there is extra time they may choose another library track(s) to play.

Walter will be here to greet the guests as they come in.* He will take care of all orientation to free you up to handle the technicalities of having them on the air. They need not stick to any formatics except:

-They must play at least two records in a row without talking. They may talk over record intros wherever they wish within the two records outlined. Otherwise the music flow should not be stopped except at the stop sets as usual. The one exception to this rule is during news hours when there are no spots on the log just before the newscast. In that case, they may go on the air to back announce their set before the news begins.

-On the first break for each guest, you should announce who they are; you may read all or a portion of their letter (not the music lists). The rest of the hour is their show. They should do all back announcing, promos, tags, etc. You may jump in only if they either request it, or if they get totally tongue tied and you have to do something to save the day.

-Music sheets need not be followed. nor do you have to worry about Cancon. With the lists we have chosen, we should be over 20% for the day, especially with the one person who is going to do all Cancon in his hour. DO NOT DISCUSS MUSIC SHEETS OR ANY STATION POLICY WITH THE LISTENERS. If they want to know about the do not air stickers—it is simply to help avoid announcer confusion with cueing up wrong tracks. Any other policy information is strictly confidential.

-All winners have been informed that they may only bring one guest, and only if absolutely necessary. Any guests should be invited into the studio to see the operation, and then should be invited to wait in the lounge until the hour is completed.

-Guests can say their goodbyes either at the normal time (:45) or over the intro to their last record. They should also at that time promote the next guest coming up (Scott MacLean should obviously promote Chris Sheppard after 8). You will also find attatched a complete list of who is on the air when. You should keep this list handy for promotion purposes on Saturday.

There should not be any repeats of tracks; if they occur, then they occur, although you might encourage the listener who will be repeating a track to save it until the end of his/her hour so if they run out of time we don't have to worry about the repeat factor.

Each winner should see Walter or Scott before they leave to pick up a gift package we have for them.

You should greet each of them at the front door (make sure the downstairs door is open all day) and make them comfortable in the lounge until the :45 break prior to their going on the air. At that time you should show them in the studio, where the announcer will take over as outlined in my other memo. Please be sure there is coffee brewed for our guests should they require it.

When each guest is done, you should present them with their gift packs that Phil Evans is preparing and will leave in the newsroom overnight Friday. In addition to the goodies that Phil has prepared, you should tape each hour in foreground and include the tape in the package. Tapes should include all music played, and must be turned over on the half hour (most of the tapes I've left you are 60 minutes in length). Please try to turn the tapes over while music or commercials are playing so we don't lose any of the listeners on the air.
